SUBJECT: \$60 Million Investment Freed with the Effort of Board of Investment

Islamabad: 20 December 2010: It is an overachievement to land a new Airblue aircraft in Pakistan worth \$60 Million investment with the efforts of BOI chief Saleem H.Mandviwalla. It is informed that an aircraft of AirBlue was freed from Toulouse France where the delivery of aircraft was pending due to some technical reasons. To solve the matter, Minister of State/Chairman Board of Investment requested Turkish Government to give air itinerary to the Pakistani plane.

MOS/Chairman informed that AirBlue is the first private airline of Pakistan providing state of the art air travel services and buy brand new aircrafts. He told that Government has made National Aviation Policy so accommodating that privately-owned airlines like AirBlue, Shaheen etc can purchase/lease aircraft even like Airbus A330 from France or other manufactures without intervening of government.
