SUBJECT: TASK FORCE ON SECURITY FOR FOREIGN INVESTORS TO BE FORMED

ISLAMABAD, Nov 27 : Minister for Investment Senator Waqar Ahmed Khan has said that Special Task Force on Security is underway which will provide complete security to cover the investors and their employees. The Minister for Investment said this while talking to the Ambassador of China Luo Zhao Hui and the Ambassador of Germany Dr. Michael Koah, who met him here Thursday.
